SRE Policy Parent Consultation 2021


Parents were asked:

Are there any changes or additions that you feel should be made to the Jigsaw RSE Policy?

Some suggestions were made and consideration of these points will be given in lesson delivery:

- 'It looks great. I would just say that it's really important when talking about keeping private parts private that it's emphasised that it's ok to be checked by a doctor.' Staff will ensure that this very important point is made clear.
- 'Internet safety I feel social media should also be covered within this as there is a lot of pressure on youngsters with social media'. Safe use of social media is covered in the 'Healthy Me' unit of Jigsaw, in Years 5 and 6. We also cover additional work on this through our computing curriculum.
- 'Could we colour code sections to show what is statutory and what is optional for parents.' We have ensured that the lessons which parents may request that their children are withdrawn from are specified in the policy document which can be found here.
- '[could we] mention support if mourning a loss (family member, pet)' Grief is taught within the Year 6 'Relationships' unit of Jigsaw. In other years, children mourning a loss are supported through the school's Trauma Informed approach.
