Student Council Elections!

On Tuesday, 17th September, the children will be voting for their new School Councillors. To help them feel prepared, we kindly ask parents to take some time on Thursday, 12th, or Friday, 13th September to talk with their children about the election. Accelerated Reader

Once children have completed the Read Write Inc. program and become fluent readers, they transition to becoming "Rainbow Readers." At this stage, they will sit a STAR test in school, which determines their Zone of Proximal Development (ZPD). This ZPD helps guide children in selecting books that match their reading level for focused learning. These books will replace their phonics books as part of their learning. After finishing a book, children can use the QR code below to access our school's portal and complete a short quiz at home. This helps teachers monitor reading progress and comprehension. Alongside this, children will still have their library book (their book for love) that they can share with you.




