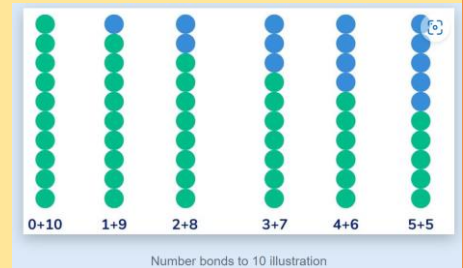


Year 6 – Autumn 1

For the next half term children will be learning their number bonds up to 1000

1. Number bonds to 10
2. Number bonds to 20
3. Number bonds to 100 (multiples of 10)
4. Number bonds to 50
5. Number bonds to 100
6. Number bonds to 1000
7. Ultimate challenge- Number bonds to 1 (decimals)



Number bonds are pairs of numbers that can be added together to make another number e.g. $4 + 6 = 10$. They are some of the most basic and most important parts of maths for children to learn.
