**Children should be able to answer these questions in any order, including missing number questions e.g.  $3 \times \bigcirc = 18$  or**

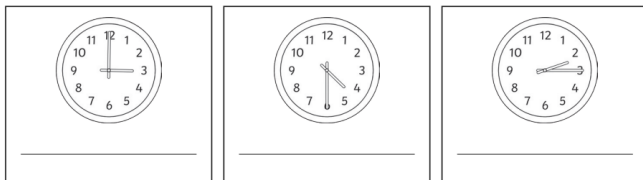
$$\bigcirc \div 6 = 4.$$
